Dear Parish Family, both near and far away,

World Youth Day in Portugal Perhaps you were keeping up with the news from Portugal about World Youth Day. About 1.5 million young people from around the world gathered to pray and praise God. Pope Francis was there leading the young through the Stations of the Cross and presiding at Eucharist at large, outdoor settings. Celebrations of spirit, sacrament, and connections of young people from all corners of the world, all drawn by what it means to live in Jesus Christ.

Like St. John Paul II, Pope Francis reminded the assembled youth "Do not be afraid." Do not be afraid to embrace that God loves you. Do not be afraid to acknowledge the gifts God has given you. Do not be afraid to encounter Jesus and invite your neighbors and friends to encounter Jesus. Can you share Jesus with others just like you introduce friends to one another? And do not be afraid to be active in your Church at home, maybe even stirring things up, being active and even a bit messy. Jesus was not afraid to overturn tables or the conventions of his day. What can you and I do to show our love for God and love for our neighbor? How can you and I share what we have with a world that hungers and thirsts for all that Jesus has to offer?

We listened to each other talk about the needs of our communities and many things going on all around us. 


