

#### Here's some more helpful schedule information for the next few weeks:

Deacon Pat Bradley offered a presentation on Sacrament of the Sick and End-of-Life Questions at St. Mary's last week. He will offer it at St. Patrick's Parish Center on Thursday, November 16 at 6:30 pm.

There will be an ecumenical Thanksgiving Prayer Service at Christ Church (70 Mansion Street, Coxsackie) on Tuesday, November 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 pm. The Feast of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated on Thursday, December 7<sup>th</sup> at 6 pm at St. Patrick's and on Friday, December 8<sup>th</sup> at St. Mary's at 6 pm.






