A Word (or Two) From Fr. Joe

Dear Parish Family both near and far away,

I have two things I'd like to share today: our participation in the Diocesan Appeal and Pope Francis' invitation for all the baptized to voice their dreams and ideas for the Synod of Bishops.

The Diocesan Appeal When I spoke with you at our Masses two weekends ago on the Appeal, I recounted how my experience of my extended family reminded me of our diocesan family. I have a grandmother, aunts and uncles and over 50 first cousins. We all strive to stay close to our families but it can be hard to stay in touch with the details of their lives. We may not get the chance to see each other that often, try as we might to renew relationships and stay in touch.

With so much going on in my life, the Holy Spirit helps keep me renewed and aware of those around me, whether they are my extended family, my parish family (families) or my sisters and brothers in Christ all around the world. Come, Holy Spirit and renew the face of the Earth!

Our diocesan family lives in 14 counties and 124 parishes. Our diocesan family includes our seminarians who have been welcomed so warmly by our St. Mary's and St. Patrick's families. (I spoke with the Vocations Director and we can look forward to hosting another seminarian next summer!) Our very diverse diocesan family also includes seniors and families who turn to Catholic Charities, children in our Catholic schools, college chaplains, and diocesan ministries that support parishes and individuals who turn to the Church for help.

Many of you have received information about the Appeal in the mail. I ask that you and your family prayerfully consider how we support our whole diocesan family. Please watch for the posters at church and check our website or, https://thediocesanappeal.org/, for more Appeal information.

Pope Francis calls us to share our voices In the modern era, the Pope, beginning with Pope Paul VI in 1965, gathers the bishops of the world every few years to address topics in the life of the Church. Pope Francis has called a Synod on the Family, a Synod on Young People, and Synod on the Amazon, and for 2023, a Synod on Synodality.

A Synod on Synodality? While the phrase may sound a little odd, the Synod is all about how we can be a Church that listens to all the baptized. We're a church that values communion, the way we join together, the way we strive to be one in faith. Is everyone's voice being heard? Pope St. John Paul II "opened wide the doors to Christ" to celebrate a new millennium. Our churches are emptier than they used to be. Could it be the pandemic? Or how we listen or don't listen to each other? How can we bring Christ to others and make new disciples?

Listening can lead to better understanding. We can walk with one another other even if we don't fully understand. Listen and learn. Together, we can reflect on our shared life in Jesus. Shared experiences can help us to live in communion, increase participation and open us to the mission of Jesus. This is where the Synod is going and Pope Francis invites us all to take part.

You can follow the work of the Synod in the Evangelist, on the Diocese's website (rcda.org) and in our newsletter and websites. Our diocese is currently developing the methods we'll use to participate in the Synod. I will do my best to keep you informed.



Envelopes for Fuel and Food Pantry Collections at St. Patrick's


