

**The Bible: God's Plan For Salvation** Have you ever read the whole Bible? Which one (there are many)? Which translation (there are even more)? Which Theological point of view (there are so much more)? Did you know that one approach to discovering the Bible is to examine it as being God's plan for humanity's salvation? 


