

## A Word (or Two ) From Fr. Joe

Dear Parish Family both near and far away,

There is so much news about the Synod called by Pope Francis: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission." The Pope is calling the Church to be a missionary Church, not confined to itself but one that is active in our daily world. He advocates listening, discernment and synodality. We can take the root of the word "synod" which is about walking together. That requires listening. In our society today, we've seen that listening and walking together can be a challenge for many of us.

The Pope really believes all voices have to be heard and there are a lot of voices right now. It often seems like everybody's doing the talking and nobody's doing the listening. The public discourse in our county often seems focused on challenge and insult which will not encourage people to be in a listening or synodal frame of mind.

Pope Francis encourages us to actually hear what one another is saying and then realize that we have to come to more common places to move forward. To be a missionary Church for one another is about proclaiming the good news of Jesus Christ, and by walking with people, being open to encountering Christ alive and active in our sisters and brothers.

In 2013 when Pope Francis was new in office, he began to speak about the importance of synodality. Let me share something from the experience of the Synod on the Family and the Synod on Young People. For example, for the synod on youth, he said that we just can't have a synod of bishops about young people without significant involvement from youth. So he made sure there was a listening process on every continent that invited youth to participate. Questionnaires were distributed by the bishops' conferences in every country. He was deliberate about making sure that all youth were invited, including who had drifted from our faith, and youth from Christian and non-Christian faiths as well.

The same approach held true when Pope Francis sought broad input from families of all kinds for the Synod on the Family. We can learn from many voices when we walk together and listen.

I invite you and your family, your household to participate in this Synod for a Synodal Church. At this time, our Diocese is seeking input from the widest, most diverse gathering possible using online sessions. The next session is on Tuesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> with a morning group at 10 am and an evening group at 7 pm; the theme is "All the Baptized – Co-responsible for Mission.'

**Use Your IRA to Support Your Parish:** As we begin a new year it's good practice to look ahead and formulate a plan for our finances. For parishioners with Individual Retirement Accounts (IRA), there is an option available to you that permits you to support your parish and enjoy a tax benefit.

At age 72 Individual Retirement Account (IRA) owners must withdraw an annual required minimum distribution (RMD) from their accounts. These withdrawals are normally taxable pushing people into a higher tax bracket.

<u>Did you know you can make a Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD) to a registered non-profit using the funds from your RMD?</u> Your Catholic Parishes are considered non-profits. QCDs are generally not considered taxable income and do count toward fulfilling your annual RMD. QCDs must be paid directly from your IRA to the charity of your choice. You can benefit regardless of whether you itemize or take the standard deduction. <u>Consult with your financial advisor for any questions you may have.</u>


