The Presentation of the Lord

So often, our early February newsletter is filled with news about upcoming Ash Wednesday celebrations and Lenten activities. This year is different. Ash Wednesday is on March 5th and Easter is on April 20th. Please check our next newsletter for Ash Wednesday and Lenten news.

This weekend Catholics celebrate the Presentation of the Lord, a feast day that falls 40 days after Christmas. Our Gospel (Luke 2: 22-38) is the retelling of Mary and Joseph taking Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. Once there, they encounter Anna and Simeon. They have been praying in the temple for years, waiting for the Christ and they praise this newborn Son.

On this feast day, candles to be used in church throughout the year are blessed. Parishioners who bring candles from home can have these candles blessed as well. The tradition of blessing candles on this day flows from the words of Simeon in today's Gospel, that Jesus would "be a light to the Gentiles and a glory to the people of Israel."

The Even though the memorial day for St. Blaise falls on a Monday this year, the St. Blaise blessing will be provided at the end of our Masses this weekend.


