

### Dear Parish Family and Friends, both near and far,

**Jubilee 2025, a Holy Year called for by Pope Francis** Pope Francis has declared 2025 to be a Jubilee Year. In today's newsletter, and from time to time this year, I will give you some information to read and pray over to know more about the Jubilee Year and consider how you might participate in this celebration.

Continuing from our last newsletter, here are a few more things to know about Jubilee 2025:

--Called to be Pilgrims of Hope, Pope Francis invites people to be patient which he describes "as a virtue closely linked to hope." In our times, "the future may give rise to conflicting feelings, ranging from confident trust to apprehension, from serenity to anxiety, from firm conviction to hesitation and doubt. Some people feel nothing can bring them happiness. May the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope. God's word helps us find reasons for hope."

--The Jubilee Year calls Christians to action. Pope Francis called for "signs of hope" in the Jubilee Year, including the desire for peace in the world, openness to life, responsible parenthood, and closeness to prisoners, the poor, the sick, the young, the elderly and migrants and people in difficult situations. The Pope has called on affluent countries and societies to forgive debts and be attentive to the condition of the Earth, "our common home."

--While there will be many events in Rome, please know there will be events marking the Jubilee 2025, a Year of Hope in the Albany Diocese. You may check the Diocesan website (https://www.rcda.org) for information on local events.

#### **Two opportunities in January**

The Third Sunday of Ordinary Time, **Word of God Sunday**, celebrates the special place the Word has in our lives and in our Church. (He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. Luke 24:45). Next weekend, consider making a commitment to read the Bible at home and to listen deeply and attentively to the Word proclaimed at Mass each weekend. Lectors will receive a blessing and a commissioning for their service in 2025.

**The International Week of Prayer for Christian Unity** will be celebrated January  $18^{th} - 25^{th}$  as an octave of prayer for visible Christian unity ("...that they all may be one." John 17:21 "You shall love the Lord your God and your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10:27). We pray for charity, mercy, justice and unity in ecumenical relationships.




