Dear Parish Family, both near and far away,

Our parishes will honor our graduating high school seniors... this Saturday at the 4:30 Mass at St. Patrick's and next Sunday at the 11:30 Mass at St. Mary's. Blessings to our grads as our prayers and best wishes accompany our grads on the next part of their journeys!

Father's Day is coming up on June 19th. Let me wish a Happy Father's Day to all fathers, grandfathers, godfathers and uncles. Thank you for sharing life, love and faith with us all.

A few weeks ago, parishioners from St. Mary's and St. Patrick's joined their sisters and brothers from parishes throughout Columbia and Greene Counties to take part in the Synodal Listening session held at Holy Trinity in Hudson. After some discussion at our June parish council meetings, we will offer Synodal Listening sessions at both St. Mary's and St. Patrick's on Sunday, June 26th... at St. Patrick's in our Parish Hall after 9:30 Mass and at St. Mary's in Maria Hall after the 11:30 Mass. Thank you to everyone who has given to the Diocesan Appeal. We all know the cost of living has increased and family budgets are tight. For some, this year's gift has been less. 


