## Please welcome Fr. Jay Atherton

Folks, this weekend, Fr. Jay Atherton is with us to preside at our Masses at St. Mary's and St. Patrick's. Fr. Jay is our pastor, the pastor of our ten parish local Parish Network encompassing St. Patrick's in Ravena and all nine of the Greene County parishes. Fr. Kyle Eads, Fr. Mike Melason and I all collaborate with him in sacramental and pastoral ministry.

This is Fr. Jay's first visit to our parishes as our pastor and he will be with us for weekend Masses and meetings from time to time in the future. He wants to know the people and parishes of our region. Please give him the same warm greeting you gave me when I first came here in September '21. When he is here, I will be presiding at Eucharist in other parishes in Greene County. I will see you next week at our Masses for All Saints Day and All Souls' Day!

### **Special November Days of Prayer**

Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup> is All Saints Day, a holy day of obligation. Wednesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> is All Souls' Day. Both of these days hold a special place in our hearts. The Saints and the Souls of our deceased family members, neighbors and friends... all those saints, whether canonized or not... mean a great deal to us and we almost reflexively respond to the invitation to come and pray... with them and for them. And we seek the prayer of the Communion of Saints to pray for us and interceded on our behalf.

We gather this week... for All Saints Day on Tuesday (the 1<sup>st</sup>) at St. Mary's at 6 pm and for All Souls' Day on Wednesday (the 2<sup>nd</sup>) at St. Patrick's at 6 pm. All Souls' Day is also the day members of our parish family gather to remember recently deceased members of their families and friends and neighbors as well. Please come and pray as our parish family on Tuesday and Wednesday night this week.

Please bring a framed picture of a deceased loved one for our Altar of Remembrance. At both St. Mary's and St. Patrick's, we will pray for our sacred dead all through the month of November. See Deacon Mike, Deacon Steve, your greeter or me and we will help you place your picture of your loved one among the pictures of the many people we will remember in prayer this month.

## **RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**

The RCIA process emphasizes personal conversion and a commitment to the Catholic way of life. You may be wondering.....is the RCIA process for me?

RCIA is for three groups of people: - Those who are not baptized - Those who were baptized in another Christian denomination and want to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church - Baptized Catholics who have not completed the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.




