Dear Parish Family, both near and far away,

Our Parish Network... Taking another step

You may recall Fr. Jay Atherton's announcement in mid-December that our Parish Network was looking to organize administrative services to support our eight parishes (and all ten worship sites), that is, to centralize business office activities our parishes share in common by the end of January. Just a few days ago, Dawn Brownson, who will now serve as our Parish Network Business and Operations Director, began supervising four network employees who will be working, at least for now, in offices at St. Patrick's in Catskill.

Our St. Mary's and St. Patrick's churches <u>and</u> our parish offices will remain open. We will continue to keep our St. Mary's and St. Patrick's offices open using volunteers, following current schedules. Our parishes will introduce the Mission Central program we have at St. Mary's so parishioners can 'get things done/have questions answered' after weekend Masses. (I've heard some people call it 'one-stop Church.') Dawn and her team will still serve our administrative needs. Congratulations to Dawn in her new role! I know she will continue to serve us well.

As is true in all transitions, I know there will be moments when new methods and new ways of doing things won't be as smooth as the way they were done before. This new approach looks to serve our needs in a more efficient way with less duplication of effort and roles. This approach promises to be a better use of your donations, your stewardship support of our communities.

Please pray for us and be patient with us at this time. Also, St. Mary's and St. Patrick's will need of more volunteers to help serve our communities. I will have more information (and some requests) in the coming weeks. Please look into your hearts to discern how you might use your gifts to serve your parish and your neighbors.


