And Who is my Neighbor? Part 2 Parishioners met at St. Patricks' and St. Mary's during the week. We listened to each other talk about the needs of our communities. We'll meet again at St. Patrick's on Monday, August 21st and at **St. Mary's on Monday, August 28th and on Thursday, September 7^{th.}** All the meetings will be at 6:30 pm. At the St. Mary's conversation, it was learned that since 2020, the Coxsackie Area Food Pantry has almost doubled the number of families served each month. Coupled with prices rising at the Northeast New York Regional Food Bank during this time, the Food Pantry needs the financial help of the community to help feed our neighbors. We're sharing this with the St. Mary's community and asking for your support for the Food Pantry.

How can you support your neighbors in need? At this time, you can:




