Ash Wednesday is March 5th. Here's what happening closer to home:

- --At St. Patrick's: Mass at 7 am Mass and a Liturgy of the Word Service at 6 pm
- --At St. Mary's: Liturgy of the Word services at 8 am, 12 noon and 6 pm Ashes will be distributed at all Masses and Liturgy of the Word Services at St Mary's and St. Patrick's. Communion will be available at the Liturgy of the Word Services.
- --Also, please bring your old palm to church on the weekends of February 22-23 and March 1-2. Your old palm will be burned to provide ashes we'll distribute on Ash Wednesday. Please watch for more information on Lenten activities in our next newsletter.


