DISCUSSION

May we love all members of the Church, including those who approach faith differently than we do; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love our pope, bishops, leaders, and elected officials, whether we would have chosen them for their posts or not; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love all young people, including those who fail to live up to our dreams and expectations for them; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love our elderly, who may at times make demands on our time and attention that burden us; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love all those workers who serve others: in restaurants and gas stations, in retail jobs and hotels, in hospitals and nursing homes; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love our mothers, living or dead – no matter how good they have been at loving and nurturing us in the way we need; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.

May we love the poor, who Jesus promised would always be with us and who can help us love You better because of them; we pray... Lord, hear our prayer.
