Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

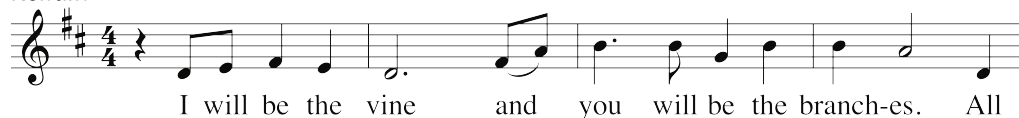

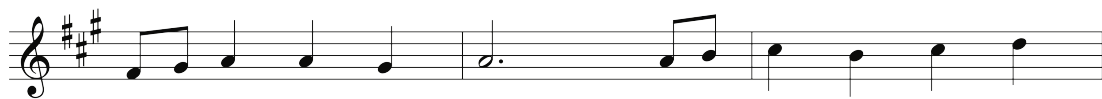
