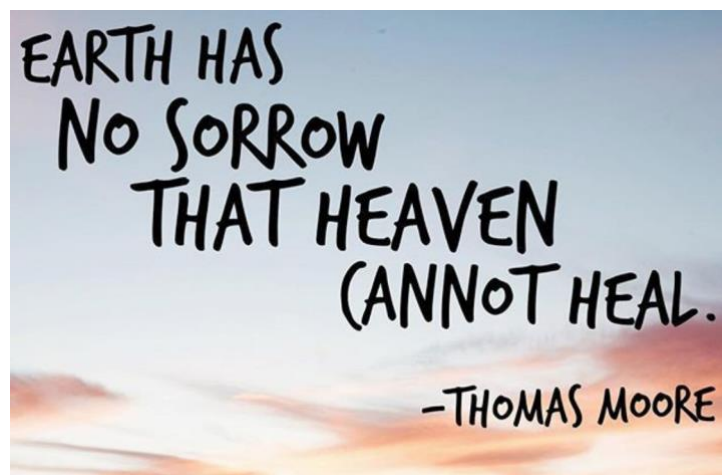
GOSPEL PASSAGE
