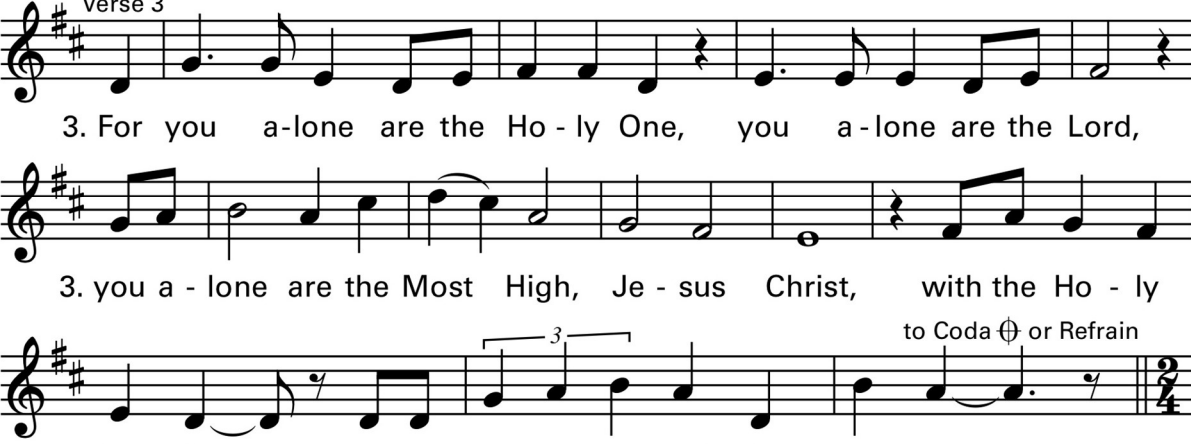

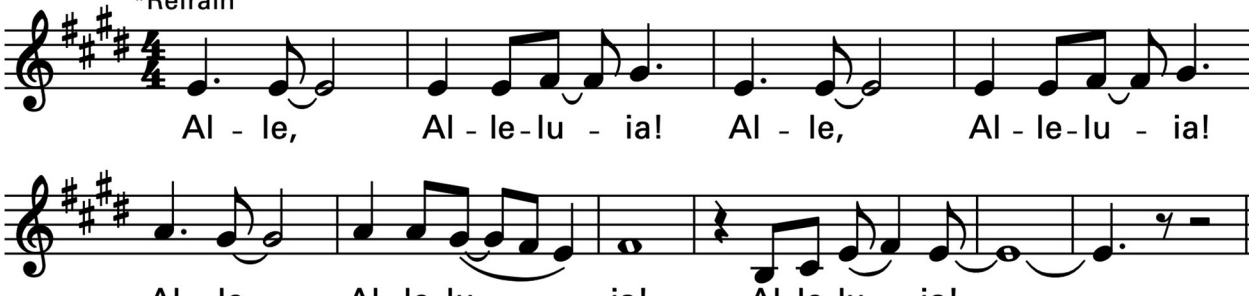

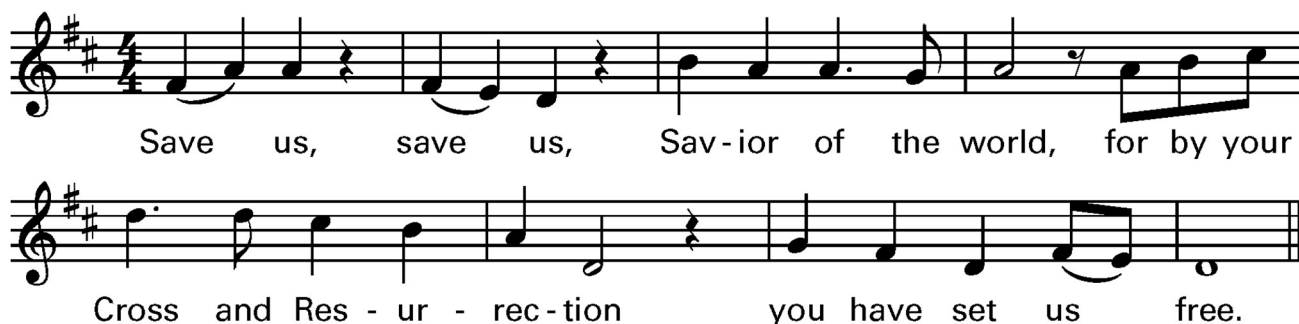

INVITATION TO COMMUNION

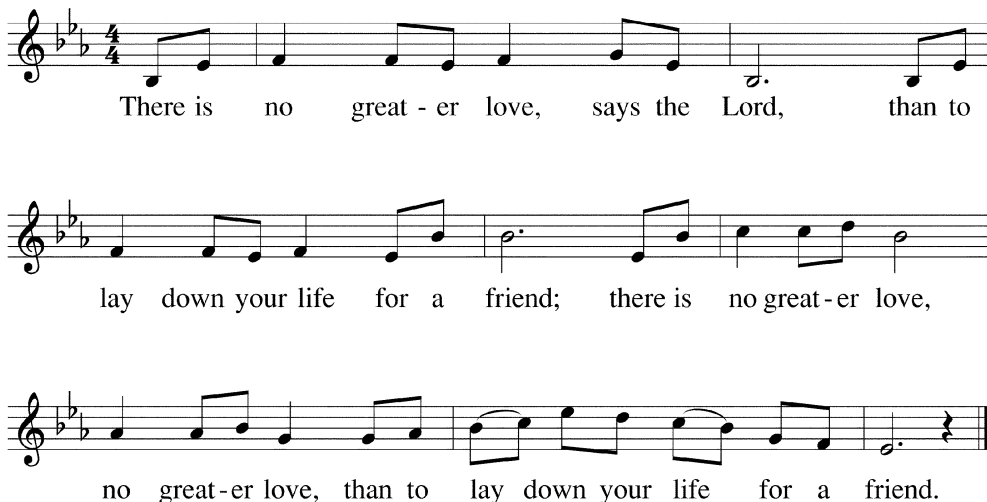
- V. Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world.

If you are not Catholic, or for spiritual, medical, or other reasons receiving Communion is not the right choice for you today, you can still come forward for a blessing. Simply fold your arms across your chest as you approach the priest or deacon.
